Aspen is a WestBred Hard White wheat best adapted to the Great Plains. It has good soil borne and foliar protection, along with early maturity and strong straw. Aspen has good pre-harvest sprouting resistance. Excellent straw strength makes Aspen a good choice for irrigation. This variety has shown exceptional yield potential in Kansas and Colorado.
