KEOTA

Keota is a hard red winter variety WestBred marketed by AGSECO. This variety is primarily adapted to western Kansas and eastern Colorado. Keota offers excellent protection from stripe rust and is moderately resistant to wheat streak mosaic virus. It has very good straw strength and good grazing potential, making it a good candidate to replace TAM 110 on a significant amount of acres in Northwest Kansas and Northeastern Colorado. Yield performance of Keota in its area of adaptation has been outstanding.
