



# SHOCKER

Shocker is a hard red winter variety WestBred licensed to AGSECO. Shocker is best adapted to the wheat growing areas south of I-70. It possesses excellent foliar and soil borne disease protection, combined with early maturity. Erect juvenile growth habit is conducive to grazing. Shocker was the top yielding experimental line in the 2005 USDA Southern Regional Performance Nursery for the South Central Zone. This is an exceptional variety for producers in the southern 1/2 of Kansas and all of Oklahoma.
